Show will use HCBC rules unless otherwise listed.

- Show Management reserves the right to combine, add/or remove classes or divisions or adjust prizes.
- Stabling at \$15/night (\$10 for NSC Members) (shavings free on site). Clean stall deposit is \$25.00 on a separate cheque.
- Washrooms are on site, no showers.
- Refunds will not be issued without a Vet or Doctor's note.
- Post entries will only be accepted with an additional \$20.00 fee per horse/rider combo if our max numbers allow.
- Dressage Riders may ride up to three (3) dressage tests. You must provide your own reader.
- Dressage classes are open to horses and ponies.
- Dressage FREESTYLES – riders will be responsible for bringing their own music. Music must be given to the Sound Co-ordinator when picking up numbers. Instructions for starting the music need to be simple and clearly labeled.
- Hunter & Jumper Riders may enter four (4) classes ( two hieght divisions ) for the day but they must be consecutive for each horse entered.
- 2 refusals allowed before elimination at this schooling show
- Prizes to 3<sup>rd</sup> place Ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup> place.

# Afternoon Classes – Hunter & Jumper

## Class Descriptions:

- **Welcome Hunter:** To be judged on way of going, manners and style of jumping
- **Hunter Equitation:** To be judged **solely on the ability of the rider to show his or her horse.** Thus, the communication between horse and rider through subtle cues and aids should not be obvious. Equitation is judged on the rider and her/his effect on the horse while executing a pattern.
- **Welcome Jumper :** Table A- First round has a time allowed but in the event of clear round (no penalties) there will be an immediate jump-off against the clock. Other athletes are placed according to their penalties in the first round. Jumping faults (change in height of jump) or the first refusal generate 4 penalty points. 2 refusals result in elimination
- **Power and Speed:** The course is divided into two parts, with the first being the "power" part, and the second being the "speed" portion. If you go clear and within time for the power part of the course, you immediately – without stopping – continue to the speed section of the course, in which you aim to go a bit faster. The fastest time for the second part of the course wins.

## Northern Saddle Club the "Organizer"

### **WAIVER OF LIABILITY FOR ALL CLAIMS AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY**

1. Has not travelled internationally during the last 14 days;
2. Has not visited a COVID-19 high risk area, region or location in Canada during the last 14 days;
3. Does not knowingly have COVID-19;
4. Is not experiencing known symptoms of COVID-19, such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath, and if experiences such symptoms during the Event will immediately depart from the Event;
5. Has not, in the past 14 days, knowingly come into contact with someone who has COVID-19, who has known symptoms of COVID-19, or is self-quarantining after returning to Canada; and
6. Follows government recommended guidelines in respect of COVID-19, including practicing physical distancing, and will do so to the best of the Participant's ability during the Event.
