- Show Management reserves the right to combine, add or remove classes or divisions or adjust prizes.
- Stabling at \$20/night (\$15 for NSC Members) shavings free on site.
- Clean stall cleaning fee of \$15.
Stalls will be cleaned by members of the BV Pony Club as one of their fund raising activities
- Washrooms are on site, no showers.
- Refunds will only be issued up to the Thursday evening before the show with a Vet or Doctor's note.

Hunter Class Descriptions:

- **Welcome Hunter:** To be judged on way of going, manners and style of jumping
- **Hunter Equitation:** To be judged **solely on the ability of the rider to show his or her horse.** Thus, the communication between horse and rider through subtle cues and aids should not be obvious. Equitation is judged on the rider and her/his effect on the horse while executing a pattern.

1. Has not travelled internationally during the last 14 days;
2. Has not visited a COVID-19 high risk area, region or location in Canada during the last 14 days;
