 - i. **ACTION ITEM 5:** Anika will call either HCBC or CAPRI to determine if CRHRA insurance is compatible with our HCBC club membership
 - d. Barefoot Trimming Course
 - i. Anika received correspondence of an offer to put on a clinic through the club. **ACTION ITEM 6:** Anika will respond with a link to our rental rates and suggest they look for interest to put on the clinic themselves.
 - e. Storage Container
 - i. Erin presented information on options for show jump storage. New jumps are getting wrecked moving place to place, left out to rot or not put away properly. Options: 1. 20' Seacan is \$8500+gst+delivery, 2. wood is expensive and would require permit/siding, 3. Galvanized Steel buildings 13' long, 7' wide, 7' tall with 4' door for \$3200+gst (and ~\$200 to make wooden pole rack). We will require 2 buildings for a total cost of \$7000. There is also a HCBC core grant that may cover one of the buildings, due April 15th.
 - Motion to spend \$7000 on 2 galvanized steel buildings + lumber for pole racks & M/S Erin/Geri, AIF-Tabled
 - **ACTION ITEM 7:** Erin to apply for HCBC core grant for building by April 15th.
